



2023 -2024 Competitive Cheer Class Requirements

VARSETY

Class A & B

- Minimum 12 athletes on the mat and 3 stunt groups.
- Maximum 24 athletes on the mat and 6 stunt groups.
- If you do not meet the minimum or exceed the maximum, you will receive the 3-point class violation deduction.
- Please note that this is separate from the Max. Participation Driver (.5)

Class C, D & Coed

- Minimum 8 athletes on the mat and 2 stunt groups
- Maximum 20 athletes on the mat and 5 stunt groups
- If you do not meet the minimum or exceed the maximum, you will receive the 3-point class violation deduction.
- Please note that this is separate from the Max. Participation Driver (.5)

JV & MS (different from Varsity)

All Classes (A, B & C)

- Minimum 8 athletes on the mat and 2 stunt groups
- Maximum 24 athletes on the mat and 6 stunt groups
- If you do not meet the minimum or exceed the maximum, you will receive the 1-point class violation deduction.
- Therefore, in terms of JV and MS, if all teams have 8 athletes and 2 stunt groups, they will not receive a class violation deduction.
- Please note that this is separate from the Max. Participation Driver (.5)

To be clear, as long as the team has met the class requirement, they **WILL NOT** receive a class requirement violation. Regardless of how many athletes they have on the mat compared to the amount of stunts groups performing, this is not a class requirement violation. If they should have more stunt groups due to the amount of athletes on the mat, that will **ONLY** be reflected in the Max. Participation Driver score (.5).
