



2025-2026 Competitive IMPORTANT HOSTING INFORMATION

New for 2025 – Electronic Scoring

- Host school is REQUIRED to provide the following:
 - Wi-Fi
 - A backup Hot spot
 - Power Strips
 - Printed out Score Sheets in case of a disturbance
 - Printed out tally sheet in case of a disturbance

Electronic Scoring

- The “Head Judge” at the competition will enter the teams’ names and Division.
- At the conclusion of the competition, the head judge will email the host school coach with the “View Only” version. Please make sure to provide that judge with the email you want it sent to at some point in the evening.
- It is the responsibility of the host school coach to then email the participating schools, Brianne, SCCCA and Section XI the results.

Administration Presence: Please make sure you have an administrator present and available at all times in the event a situation occurs.

Gym Lay-out - NEW for 2025

- Flip the Gym.
- Spectators on the side
- VIP Area for fans of performing team
- Officials on one end of gym, the 9 panels on the other side as far back as possible
- DJ location will be determined by the host school and the best placement for their gym.

Session Times:

It is the responsibility of the Host school to make sure the Officials are in the gym 5 minutes before the first team is set to perform. If the Session starts at 9:00 AM, please ask the officials to be in the gym by 8:55 AM. Please give them a 10-minute heads up before the start. National Anthem should be 10 minutes before the start of the competition. The 1st team should compete at start time.

Officials Table

- Must have power in case the electronic device needs to be plugged in. (Ext. cords, power strips, etc.)

Warm-ups:

- A coach and or qualified adult MUST be supervising the warm up Gym.
- Only athletes of the team warming up are allowed in the Warm-up Gym.
- No warmup Official
- It is the responsibility of the Host school to make sure the on-deck team is waiting outside the warm-up gym 10 minutes before their warm-up time.
- Host school must provide sound system with the Aux or Bluetooth connection for warmups.
- 8 minutes on 9 practice cheer mats; with the appropriate Velcro (ONLY); NO wrestling mats.

Admission

- \$5 dollars per person during regular season scheduled contests.

Sales

- Concession, spectator admission, vendors and t-shirt sales go to host school during regular season.

It is your responsibility as the Host to run your competition. Please make sure that warmups and the main gym are running on time. If there is a delay in the main gym, it is your responsibility to pause the warmup gym accordingly.

If there is any issue throughout the day, it is the responsibility of the host school and AD to take care of the issue. Do not contact the Section XI coordinator.
